**Articulation Agreement Between
North Coast Tech Prep Partnership and Cuyahoga Community College
Student Form**

**North Coast Tech Prep High Schools:
Medina County Career Center**

Leading to an Associate Degree at Cuyahoga Community College:

For the purpose of this agreement, a Tech Prep student is defined as a student who is enrolled in and completed the prescribed curriculum pathway for grades 9-12. This pathway has been identified and approved by high school and college administrators as a curriculum that provides the students with the academic and technical competencies that have been developed through a Career Field Standards review process or similar procedure. This process ensures a seamless learning progression of technical and academic skills from high school to college.

TO RECEIVE CREDIT THE STUDENT MUST:

1. Earn a 3.0 GPA in an approved high school Tech Prep Program.
2. Earn a high school cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher grades 9 through 12.
3. Pass Algebra 2 (or equivalent) prior to graduation from high school.
4. Submit a CCC application prior to graduation from high school.
5. Submit an Articulation Agreement, signed by the student and high school teacher, prior to graduation from high school.

HYBRID LEARNING EXPERIENCE ARTICULATED CREDIT

To be eligible for Hybrid Learning Experience credit, seniors must complete the mandatory scheduled Hybrid Learning Experience session and successfully complete the exams. Upon successful completion of the Hybrid Learning Experience the student is eligible to receive:
