Leading to an Associates Degree at Cuyahoga Community College:

For the purpose of this agreement, a Tech Prep student is defined as a student who is enrolled in and completed the prescribed curriculum pathway for grades 9-12. This pathway has been identified and approved by high school and college administrators as a curriculum that provides the students with the academic and technical competencies that have been developed through a Career Field Standards review process or similar procedure. This process ensures a seamless learning progression of technical and academic skills from high school to college.

TO RECEIVE CREDIT THE STUDENT MUST:

1. Earn a 3.0 GPA in an approved high school Tech Prep Program.
2. Earn a high school cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher in grades 9 through 12.
3. Pass Algebra 2 (or equivalent) prior to graduation from high school.
4. Submit a CCC application prior to graduation from high school.
5. Submit an Articulation Agreement, signed by the student and high school teacher, prior to graduation from high school.

ARTICULATED CREDIT

BRIDGE COURSE CREDIT

Upon successful completion of a one (1) week Junior Bridge Course, the student is eligible to receive the following credit:

HTEC 1040 Health Careers Exploration **1 Semester Hour**

HYBRID LEARNING EXPERIENCE

To be eligible for Hybrid Learning Experience credit, seniors must complete the Four (4) mandatory scheduled Hybrid Learning Experience sessions and successfully complete the exams. successful completion of the Hybrid Learning Experience the student is eligible to receive the following credit:

The maximum Comparable Credit a student can receive is 30 semester credits as stated in the Cuyahoga Community College Comparable Credit Policy.

Students who successfully meet the above requirements will receive credit to apply towards the Associate of Applied Science Degree in Health Professions and Related Sciences or students may choose to earn any Associate Degree. Earned credit will be awarded in the form of Transfer Credit without cost to the student.

***This agreement is open for review on a yearly basis as deemed necessary by the high school or college.**
