

Cardboard Canoe Challenge

April 22, 2005



To design and build a cardboard boat that is human powered, and race around a pre-determined course in the metro campus pool.

Creative students are asked to design, build, and race a boat made entirely out of cardboard. The objective of the race is to give students the chance to overcome problems using unconventional materials while having fun. Teams of no more than five Tech Prep students will design, build, and race their boat at the Cuyahoga Community College Metro Campus Pool. Schools may enter more than one team.

The date of the Third Annual Cardboard Canoe Competition is Friday, April 22, 2005.

The competition will include an oral presentation by each team and the canoes will speed around buoys in the pool. Speed and maneuverability will be the key to winning.

There will be a Grand Champion and awards will be given for Best Presentation and Speed.

Eligibility is limited to Tech Prep students enrolled in a drafting / computer aided design or machine technology course in high school.

Each team must complete a race application and submit to the North Coast Tech Prep office two weeks prior. (DUE APRIL 8, 2005)
